









How worried are you about your child having anger or acting out?





How worried are you about your child being sad or withdrawn?





How worried are you about your child being defiant?







Active diagnosis of anxiety among Medicaid eligible K-12 students




Active diagnosis of depression among Medicaid eligible K-12 students

Active diagnosis of major depressive disorder among Medicaid eligible K-12 students




Active diagnosis of any behavioral health condition among Medicaid eligible K-12 students






Teen Birth Rate (per 1,000 girls age 15-19)





Crashes caused by distracted drivers in Ohio




Percent of car crashes caused by teens in 2024




Dental visits among K-12 students eligible for Medicaid




How concerned are you about your children getting adequate sleep?









Active diagnosis of substance use disorder among K-12 students eligible for Medicaid







How concerned are you about your children engaging in self-harm?















Infant* mortality rate (deaths per 1,000 live births)
















Percent of public school children who experienced homelessness at some point during the school year







Renters living in unaffordable housing






















Households without access to a vehicle





Lead poisoning rate among children aged under 6








Share of adults ages 25 - 54 who are employed


Pay of an average job compared with the cost of living (for a family of 3)



















Percent of Ohio children who have had Adverse Childhood Experiences (ACEs)






























Air quality percentile - ranked nationally























Ratio of population to dentists




Ratio of population to primary care physicians













Share of 3- and 4-year-old children enrolled in a nursery school or preschool






Share of 19- and 20-year-olds with a high school degree


Share of households with a computer and broadband internet subscription in the home












Share of the voting-age population who turn out to vote


Juvenile arrests per 100,000 juveniles


Number of property crimes per 100,000 people





Number of violent crimes per 100,000 people


































Population that is under age 18


Children 0-19 with Hispanic ethnicity








Children 0-19 two or more races










