Dedication by Jennifer Briggs Jenkins, daughter of Mary, and her husband Jared Jenkins, and the Rob and Alyssa Briggs Fund with added sponsorship coordinated by Mary's good friend, Susan Flowers.

Mary was gracious, kind and loving but also fierce. She was a true leader and a champion for children. Mary was a member of the Women's Board of Akron Children's from 1983-2024, where she especially loved working on the Charity Ball and the annual spring plant sale. For 32 years, Mary served on and chaired numerous Charity Ball committees and sat on both the Women's Board Executive Committee and the Board of Trustees. Mary was so proud of the impact the Women's Board had on the hospital and the many contributions made by the board.

Mary also served as an active member of The Junior League of Akron, where she previously served as president of the league. She was instrumental in the creation of the Akron training program to create effective team members and leaders. She was active in the League's involvement with Morley Health Center and helped develop Junior Leadership Akron for area high schoolers. Mary was also an active member of Leadership Akron, receiving the Distinguished Leader Award. As a strong advocate for the most vulnerable children in



our community, Mary transferred that advocacy into service to Child Guidance and Family Solutions. Upon learning that the organization needed help with wrap-around and preventative services, she gathered a group of more than 100 powerful women and began a women's board for Child Guidance. With the support of the women judges in Akron, this group wrote a program for divorcing parents called, "Remember the Children," which is still required today for

every divorcing parent in Summit County. Mary believed in our connection with nature and each other and in love. Mary passed away on March 24, 2024. She loved her family, friends and community, and she was a true asset to Akron Children's. We honor Mary's memory. Her love, especially for the children of this community, carries on.



Celebrating 32 Years of the Children's Tree of Lights and Remembering Nancy Heslop



As we celebrate this 32-year anniversary, we want to give special acknowledgement to Associate Women's Board Member Nancy Heslop, who was the first Chair of the Children's Tree of Lights in 1994.

From Nancy's own words, "In 1993, Margie Brideweser, Judy Holder, and I had a vision that a Children's Tree of Lights may make a

wonderful project for the Women's Board. A year and a half later, after many consultations with tree and lighting experts, the Women's Board witnessed the planting of a 30-foot spruce, weighing 20,000 pounds, in Perkins Square Park. This tree, adorned with lights and our hospital Bambino on top, became our Children's Tree of Lights for patients, families and the city of Akron to enjoy. In the many years I served on the Akron Children's Women's Board, this was one of the sweetest and dearest projects I have ever worked on. I am honored to have been such an integral part of the living treasure of the Children's Tree of Lights.

The Spirit of the Children's Tree of Lights belongs to everyone who has a connection to our dear Akron Children's. In celebration of our beloved Children's Tree, we can put down our burdens and lift up our hearts." (Nancy and John Heslop)

Sadly, Nancy and John passed away in November and will be dearly missed for all that they have given to the Akron Children's community through the vision to make the first Children's Tree of Lights a reality. 
