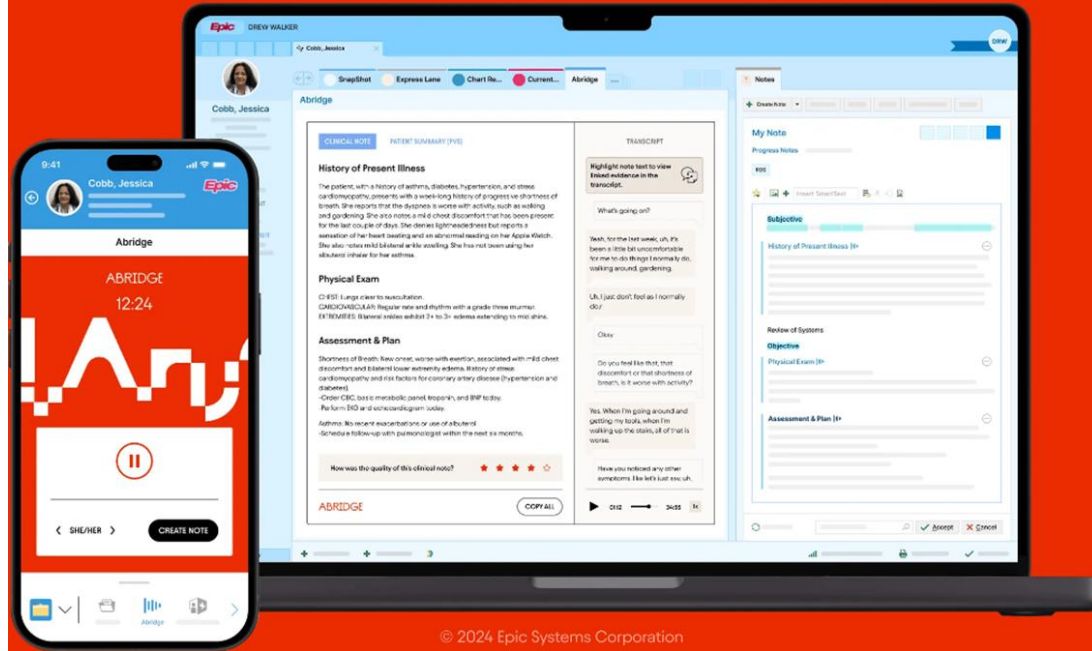

Sarah Genatst, a 10-year-old female, has a history of asthma, otitis media, dental caries, prior tonsillectomy/adenoidectomy, and seizures [8]. She experienced new-onset seizures, including collapse with arm flexion, confusion, and headache; CT and labs were normal [8]. She reported daily head-shaking movements, absence spells with confusion/activity arrest, and episodes of weakness, nausea, headache, and dizziness [8]. Neurological exams remained normal, and cognitive function was age-appropriate [8]. EEG and MRI were planned; Keppra and Valproate were prescribed, with folic acid supplementation [8]. No status epilepticus or seizure clusters occurred [8]. Hearing and vision screenings were normal [7]. She had sleep disturbance and weight gain, but no acute or chronic neuro deficits [6].

Sarah Genatst is a 10 year old female with asthma and seizure disorder controlled on medication who presents with chronic abdominal pain. She is accompanied by her mother.
