| CoV-2 | 126     | 2         | 1.6%       |

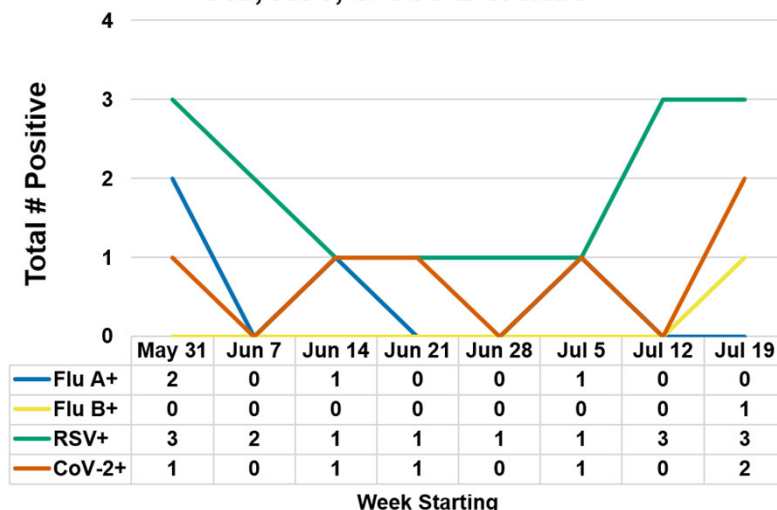

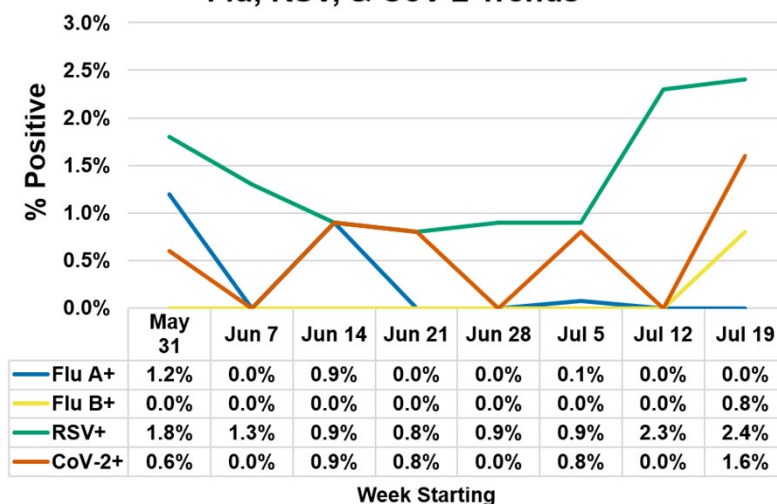


## Flu A Subtyping

The bottom chart displays the 8-week trend for positivity rate (# positive/ total # tested) Flu A, Flu B, RSV, and SARS-CoV-2.
