PL-1 through PL-3
3 weeks or 15 customary working days + 1 week holiday break
- **Step 3** - Provide full reimbursement for the cost of the examination to any resident who passes the exam by their 12th month of training
- **AAP Membership Dues**

Health and other benefits

Health Benefits

- Residents are eligible to enroll themselves and their eligible dependents in a selection of Medical, Dental, Vision, Life and Prescription benefits.
- Residents will be eligible for their health benefits on the first day of hire.



Employee Assistance Program and Health Services

- Counseling and guidance services available for the following life circumstances:
 - Stress/anxiety
 - Depression
 - Financial difficulties
 - Marital or family issues
 - Legal concerns
 - Mental health and substance abuse support
- Basic health screenings
- Follow up after work-related injuries
- Minor first aid
- Smoking cessation information and nicotine patches



Short & Long Term Disability



The hospital provides residents with Short & Long Term Disability benefits; which become effective 3 months from the effective date of your health benefits.

Short term disability is paid at 100% of salary.

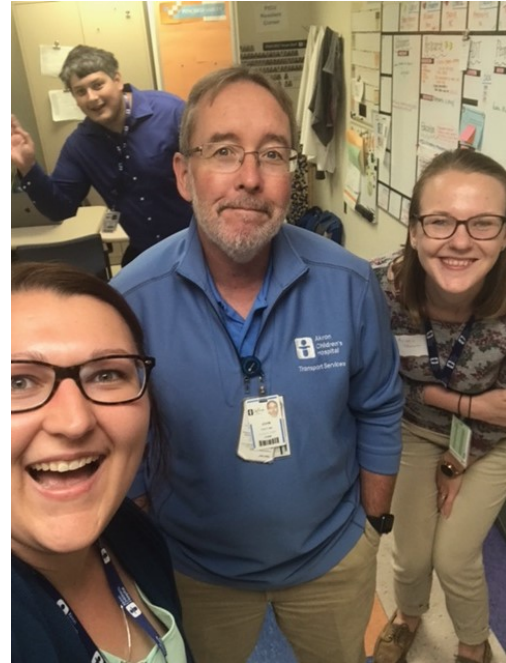
The core plan for long-term is 50% of salary; with options to upgrade.
