Children's Hospital: I was the co-chief fellow and my duties include facilitating communication between fellows and attendings, improvement of our fellowship training, arranging journal club, case discussing, on-call scheduling, recruitment of new fellows and being a part of our training committee. I recently presented my research involving children & teens who have Bipolar spectrum disorders and comorbid PTSD influencing the outcome and this study is awarded to be one of the best 3 in Akron Children's Hospital. I am also mentored a psychiatry resident about his research activity. This last year of training I am involved part-time with patient care at out pt clinic of Akron Children's Hospital as well as part-time at Child Guidance. Several of the rotations of this year include Juvenile Court, Children Services, Alcohol and Drug Rehabilitation Hospital , Neurodevelopment Clinic , school rotations as well as intensive community treatment. I am involved fellowship training committee to improve the training of our fellows as well as rotating residents. During the 2 years I was involved with teaching medical students, adult psychiatry residents and given several case presentation and journal club lectures. I graduated on June 30, 2008.

- July 2003- June 2006: Psychiatry Residency In Northeastern Ohio Universities College of Medicine (NEOUCOM): Akron, Ohio, USA. Involved in care/treatment of inpatient psychiatry patients, treatment of out-patient psychiatry patients, individual, group and couples therapy cases, consultation-liason psychiatry cases and medical student training and research activities. I was actively involved in 2 research projects. The first one examines outcome measures of total knee replacement in patients receiving extensive guided imagery pre and post operatively while the second one is regarding Neuroleptic Malignant Syndrome. During this residency I was involved in teaching child psychiatry lectures to all rotating medical students as well as teaching during inpatient rotations and consults. I passed my Board Exams recently and became a Board Certified Adult Psychiatrist.

-Sep 1999-Jan 2000 Stecker Scholarship: in child abuse in the Children's Hospital, Child Abuse Program, Columbus, Ohio, USA.

During this educational experience, I participated in medical examinations and social service interviews and forensic interviews of children who were referred as possibly suffering from child abuse. I participated in approximately 120 staff meetings, 36 of which were with prosecutors, law enforcement and Child Services and I made contributions from a psychiatric point of view to case plans for abused children. I participated in consultations on children who were suspected of being physically abused. I participated in preparing formal consultations about these children and families. I accompanied Dr. Charles Johnson to court when he testified about children who had been evaluated for as possibly being abused. I participated in 10 courtroom presentations.

I attended two meetings of the American Academy of Pediatrics Committee on Child Abuse, at one of which I presented a review of my research projects. I made site visits with Child Services and law enforcement and visited Huckleberry House, a respite for runaway children. I developed protocols and collected data for two pilot research projects one of which was to determine emotional reactions of children to the sex abuse assessment process. The other one was a review of social risk factors in families reported for child abuse and those who were not reported.

I participated as a co-therapist in a psychotherapy group for pre-adolescent girls who had been abused. The group met for 12 weeks and in some sessions I applied psychodrama techniques. In addition to my experiences in the child abuse field, I observed in the ADHD and Autism clinics at the Children's Hospital. Prior to my departure I presented a program to a group of international students and faculty on the health care system in Turkey.

-Nov 1994-May 1999 Residency in psychodrama*

*I had 360 hours of residency education in psychodrama during weekends at Bakirkoy Mental Hospital, Istanbul and was certificated by the Istanbul Psychotherapy Institute which is connected to Moreno Institute.

2 years of the residency spent in adult psychiatry rotating in inpatient and out patient clinics under supervision, having individual patients to follow, for therapy and group therapy. 6 months of rotation was in child neurology. 2.5 years spent in child and adolescent psychiatry outpatient clinics including pervasive developmental disorders clinic and ADHD clinic. During this time teaching medical students, other residents was an important part of training. During 5 years of training I was on call for adult and child psychiatry emergencies 4-6/month.

-Sep 1987-June 1993 medical student at Medical School of Istanbul : I was a part of "Brain Research" team and worked on stereotaxic methods to create "Alzheimer" like memory disorders in albino rats and presented in medical student conferences for 3 years.

PROFESSIONAL EXPERIENCE

January 1st 2011- current: I became the Program Director of Child Psychiatry Fellowship of the Department of Pediatric Psychiatry & Psychology at Akron Children's Hospital. I am an active member of General Medical Education, Fellowship Educational Committee and Residency Promotion Committees at Akron Children's Hospital. I am an active member of NEOMED Department of Psychiatry Committee, NEOMED Executive Psychiatry Committee, and NEOMED Adult Psychiatry Training Committee. As the Program Director I oversee and improve our child psychiatry fellowship training, rotations, and curriculum and continue to teach and supervise child psychiatry fellows and medical students. I continue to be a supervisor for medical students and fellows' research studies. I supervise and teach adult psychiatry residents from NEOMED Program and pediatric residents from Akron Children's Hospital. I continue to work in the outpatient clinic seeing patients and families and attend outpatient Clinical Staff meetings, Joint and MedSom Meetings. I am a member of the "Vision Team" of our department. I participated in Blue Belt and Black Belt Training in 2011.

February 2010- December 2011: I became Associate Program Training Director for Child Psychiatry

Sep 2008- December 2010: I started to work as a child psychiatry attending at Akron Children's Hospital and as an academic faculty at NEOUCOM. My clinical work included Partial Hospital Program (PHP) and outpatient clinic. I am actively involved with the training of child psychiatry fellows, adult psychiatry residents and medical students as well as continuing my research activities and supporting residents' research activities. I am a member of the child psychiatry fellowship training committee and curriculum committees. I am also involved in the training committee of adult psychiatry residency. I continue to be one of the teaching faculty for our fellowship didactic curriculum, for adult psychiatry curriculum. I participate in grand rounds. I also teach "child psychiatry" didactic at NEOUCOM. I was the therapist for weekly psychodrama group therapy at PHP between September 2008-December 2010.

Jan 2000-March 2001: child and adolescent psychiatrist/ Child & Adolescent Psychiatry Clinic of Sisli Etfal Hospital (A Children's Hospital in Istanbul)

I worked primarily as a clinician. I had an average of 8-12 psychiatric interviews every day. I saw a wide range of patients who were often diagnosed as having affective disorders, anxiety disorders, developmental disorders, adjustment disorders and elimination disorders. I had a special interest in the evaluation and treatment of Child Abuse and Post-Traumatic Stress Disorder cases. I worked as a consultant child psychiatrist in cases of pediatrics, child surgery, and in the Emergency Department. I gave two lectures a year in several hospitals to educate doctors, nurses and other medical staff about child abuse and the psychiatric disorders. I worked on two new research projects about child abuse, one of which was about the incidence of child abuse in cases of child and adolescent psychiatry patients and the correlation of child abuse with the psychiatric diagnosis. The other concerned the prevalence of PTSD in clinical cases of child and adolescent psychiatry.

Oct 2000 - to-October 2001 : Child and adolescent psychiatrist/ IREM(Izmit Rehabilitation Center for earthquake victims, Project Hope, Izmit, Turkey)

A multidisciplinary staffed unit for earthquake victims. I see approximately seven patients a day, two days a week for diagnosis and treatment. Treatment approaches include individual therapy, play therapy, psychodrama, EMDR and medication where appropriate. I work with severely traumatized children and teenagers who have PTSD, pathological bereavement or adjustment disorders.

May 1998 – December 2001 : private practice

I evaluate and treat several kinds of childhood mental disorders like ADHD, Depressive Disorders, PTSD, Anxiety disorders and Adjustment disorders. I am an eclectic child psychiatrist using dynamic psychotherapy, play therapy, psychodrama, cognitive behavioral therapy, EMDR and medication if appropriate.

Sep 1998-Sep 2000: child and adolescent psychiatrist/ Child & Adolescent Psychiatry Clinic of Istanbul Medical School

I worked as a clinician and academician having a broad spectrum of cases. I worked in ADHD and developmental disorder clinics once a week. I gave clinical supervision and lectures to residents of child psychiatry and residents of psychiatry during their child psychiatry rotation 3 days a week. I gave lectures to child psychiatry & psychiatry residents, psychologists, psychological counselors and nurses twice a year. I also gave lectures to teachers and police officers specializing in children. I had rounds with medical students 4 times a month where evaluation, diagnosis, differential diagnosis and treatment modalities were discussed. I was engaged in several research projects some of which were presented in congress and some of which were published.

January 2000– March 2001: Child and Adolescent Psychiatrist /Sisli Etfal Government Hospital

I evaluated and treated a large range of cases referred to the Child and Adolescent Psychiatry Clinic. I consulted in cases of pediatrics, child surgery and in the Emergency Department.

Board Certification Status: I have Ohio State Medical License since 2003. I am board certified in adult psychiatry since May 2008. I am board certified in Child and Adolescent Psychiatry since November 2009. I am a board certified child and adolescent psychiatrist in Turkey since 1998.
